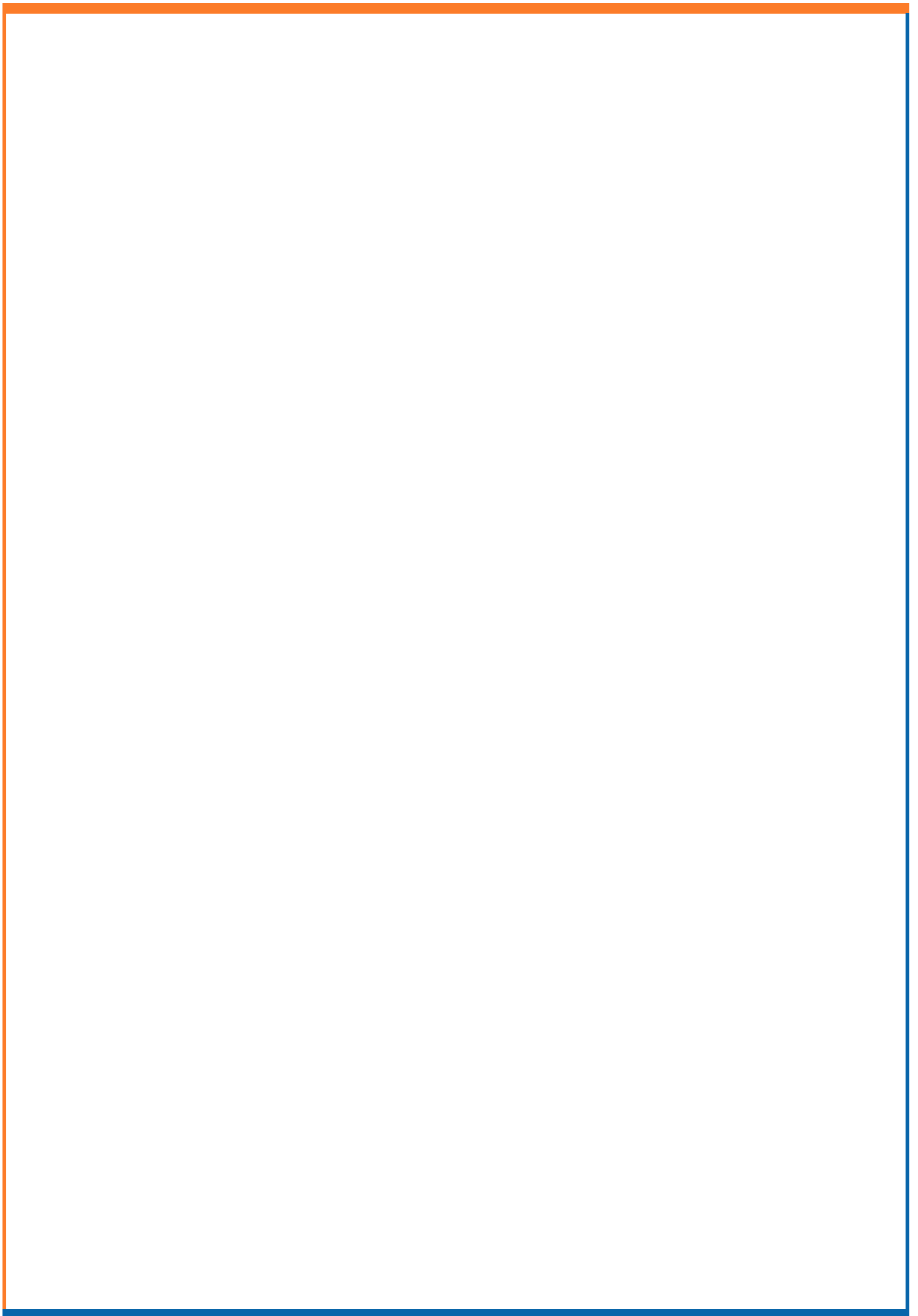

## SHOW INFORMATION:

### Pay on the Day

Not possible.

### Venue Description, Facilities & Site Rules

- Outdoor
- 3 rings
- Warm up/ Training Ring – 1 dog only at a time, 2 minutes per dog. No charge.
- Ring 1 : 35x45m grass
- Ring 2 : 50x50m sand and fibre
- Rings are enclosed with mesh fencing.
- There will be approx. 7m gap between rings.
  
- Toilets onsite
- A catering van will **NOT** be available.
  
- Parking in venue carpark
- Always pick up after your dog.
- Off-lead area

### Camping

- Optional.
- Available to book through **CHI Dog Sport at time of registration.**
- Fixed price £30 for maximum 3 nights. Arrive Friday after 3pm. Departure by noon on Monday. (No discount for 1 or 2 nights camping).
- No electric hook up.
- Grass camping.
- On-site single shower. Included in price.

### Class Description

- All classes are based on the international style of hoopers.
- Courses will consist of hoops, barrels, chutes and gates.
- All equipment will be baseless.
- There will be a separate course for the small dogs and the large dogs and for each grade so that the spacing between the equipment and course difficulty can be set appropriately.
- CHi Level 1: - as a guide this might be suitable for those new to international style or those team with modest distance handling work. E.g. CHUK starters
- CHi Level 3: - as a guide this might be suitable for those teams with full independence. E.g. CHUK advanced or masters, those attending WHOC or EO.
- Veterans: - Dogs aged over 7 years are eligible to enter as Veterans, they will run Level 1 courses only.

- Final: - points will be accrued across the 7 classes held on Saturday and Sunday. The Final will be open to the top 50% per dog height and level per the Leaderboard, the remainder may run NFC if they wish.
- CHi Rules and Regulations will be followed.

### **Dog Height**

- Small – measured at the withers, under 43mm.
- Large – measured at the withers, more than 43mm.

Proof of measurement e.g. KC agility measurement book will be accepted, else measuring available on the day.

### **Awards**

- Each class will be scored as: - most points, fastest time.
- Rosettes will be awarded per class for: - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Trophies will be awarded per class to 1<sup>st</sup> place.
- Veteran dogs run in Level 1 but compete within their own sub-category of Level 1.
  
- Over Saturday and Sunday, points from each class will be accrued over the 7 classes and a Leaderboard will be maintained (eliminations counted as zero points). Rosettes awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place per the Leaderboard Ranking and a trophy for 1<sup>st</sup> place.
  
- At the Final, rosettes will be awarded by dog height and CHi grade for **Champion & Reserve Champion** and a trophy for 1<sup>st</sup> place.

### **Running Orders**

Will not apply for individual classes.

Will apply for the Final and set as the reverse order of the Leaderboard created over the 2 days. You are responsible for being ready in the queue to run at the required time, else you will forfeit your go.

### **Not for Competition (NFC) Runs**

Permitted.

### **Reactive “Yellow” Dogs**

Hoopers is inclusive. Reactive “yellow” dogs should be clearly identified. Reactive dogs will be given adequate space.

## **Refund Policy**

In the event that the Tournament is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, refunds will be provided less reasonably incurred expenses. Refunds requested by participants within 1 month of the show date will be processed in the manner in which a competitor entered. Cancellation by the competitor after the closing date will not be refunded.

## **Welfare of Dogs**

A competitor whose dog is entered in the event or is on site should take all reasonable steps to ensure that the needs of their dogs are met and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk.

Space must be allowed for yellow dogs and competitors are required to queue 2 metres away from other competitors and their dogs and stay 2 metres away from ring fencing.

Bitches in season are allowed to compete. You must notify the show organiser and judge.

Harsh handling will not be tolerated, and you may be asked to leave the ring and or show without any refund.

## **Code of Conduct & Complaints**

- All participants will respect each other and the facilities.
- Please respect our judges. Judge's decision is final.
- Reactive "yellow" dogs will be given adequate space & consideration.
  
- If a person wishes to make a complaint against another person or their dog, it must be made to the Show Manager on the day of the event. All details of the incident must be given, along with a required £50 fee. A judge, Show Secretary or Show Manager may make a formal complaint without the required fee.
- If a person wishes to make a complaint against a CHi Accredited Trainer or other representative of CHi then this must be done with 7 days of the incident occurring and must be done in writing directly to a member of the CHi Committee.
